

# IMMIGRATION MEDICALS

## United States

We offer open access consultations on a walk-in basis. Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from **07.30** until **11.00** o'clock.

### United States Immigrant Visa applicants need to bring to their appointment:

- A currently valid passport
- 4 identical passport size photos which are less than 3 month old
- Proof of vaccination history if available
- Medical reports and/or prescribed medication (relating to already diagnosed medical conditions)
- Documents from the U.S. Consulate with Case Number if available

### United States Non-Immigrant Visa applicants need to bring to their appointment:

- A currently valid passport
- 4 identical passport size photos which are less than 3 month old
- Documents from the U.S. Consulate
- Conviction history from Ministry of Justice, if relevant
- Vaccination record, if available

### Medical examination consists of four parts:

- Physical examination
- Chest x-ray (not required for applicants younger than 15 years)
- Non-fasting blood test (not required for applicants younger than 15 years)
- Urine test (not required for applicants younger than 15 years)

A chest x-ray is required for all pregnant US Immigrant Visa applicants, without exception. You can of course defer your medical until after the end of your pregnancy if you do not wish to have the x-ray. There is no waiver available for pregnant women!

Please allow 2-3 hours for the physical examination, chest x-ray and blood test. Approximately 2 days after your examination we will receive your blood test results and complete your medical which is then collected by a courier service who will deliver the documents directly to the consulate.

Proof of the following vaccinations is required:
