

## AUSTRALIA (eMedical)

Please arrange an appointment under 069/72 22 22.

Note: For females, medical examination should not be scheduled during menstruation.

You must be able to communicate fluently in German or English, otherwise arrangements are to be made for an objective interpreter. Interpreter can **not** be a family member!

Applicants for student visas or permanent residency need to bring to their appointment:

- A current travelling passport (photocopies are not accepted!)
- Referral letter and/or **HAP-ID Number** (Note: Examination without HAP-ID Number is **not** possible!)
- Glasses
- Medical reports and/or prescribed medication (if you are suffering from a serious disease)
- Vaccination record if available

Medical examination consists of three parts:

- A physical examination (Note: During examination you need to undress to your underwear.)
- Chest x-ray (applicants from 11 years on)
- Non-fasting blood test (applicants from 15 years on)
- Urine test (applicants from 5 years on)

Please allow 2-3 hours for physical examination, x-ray, laboratory tests and record your data in eMedical.
