Please arrange an appointment for your examination by phone: **069 71 44 77 10**. We perform the examination on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from **07.30** until **11.00** o'clock. **Please note: We do not offer open access consultations on a walk-in basis any more. For organizational reasons, you must make an appointment for the examination from now on.**

United States Immigrant Visa applicants need to bring to their appointment:

- A current travelling passport
- 4 identical passport size photos which are less than 3 month old
- Proof of vaccination history if available
- Medical reports and/or prescribed medication (when suffering from a serious disease)
- Paperwork from the U.S. Consulate with Case Number if available

United States Non-Immigrant Visa applicants need to bring to their appointment:

- A current travelling passport
- 4 identical passport size photos which are less than 3 month old
- Paperwork from the U.S. Consulate
- Conviction history from Ministry of Justice, if relevant
- Vaccination record, if available

Medical examination consists of three parts:

- Physical examination
- Chest x-ray (not required for applicants younger than 15 years)
- Non-fasting blood test (not required for applicants younger than 15 years)
- Urine test (not required for applicants younger than 15 years)

A chest x-ray is required for all pregnant US Immigrant Visa applicants, without exception. You can defer your medical until after the end of your pregnancy, if you do not wish to have the x-ray. There is no waiver available for pregnant women!

Please allow 2-3 hours for physical examination, chest x-ray and blood test.

Approximately 2 days after your examination we will get your blood test results and can complete your medical which is then collected by a courier service who will deliver the documents to the consulate.

Very important: Proof of the following vaccinations is required:
